“The first winery which made me say wow was a little place called Paraiso Vineyards:

94 Paraiso Vineyards 2007 Pinot Noir Faite

Elegant ripe fruit, supple tannins and vibrant acidity. Folks this wine is a stunner. You'll definitely want to grab a few of these before they're gone, as they are down to their last 12 cases. A run don't walk buy recommendation.

92 Paraiso Vineyards 2007 Pinot Noir West Terrace

This generous wine is truly substantial. Vivid, complex aromas embrace the senses, while dark plums, ripe black fruit and soft cola and vanilla spices meld effortlessly on the palate. Plush.

91 Paraiso Vineyards 2008 Pinot Noir Santa Lucia Highlands

Fully flavored and balanced with firm acidity. Seducing aromas draw you in again and again, a winetastic experience. A wonderfully style driven Pinot Noir, that will pair with many types of food and is great on its own. Expressive aromas and enticing flavors await your purchase. Definitely worth the price of admission.”
